

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Proposed Local Law Number 3 of 2019: Local Law For Restatement of Existing Terms and Extension of Terms for Elected Officers and to override any inconsistent provision of statutes of the State of New York, specifically Town Law § 24 which sets for terms of office for elected town officers.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that a Local Law entitled: "Local Law for Restatement of Existing Terms and Extension of Terms for Elected Officers " has been introduced before the Town Board of the Town of Long Lake. This action will provide for a referendum on **two separate questions**: First, whether the office of town supervisor should be extended from two (2) years to four (4) years and second, whether the office of town highway superintendent shall be extended from two (2) years to four (4) years. The rest of the proposed local law merely restates for clarification what the current and proposed terms of offices are for all elected town officers.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the Town Board will hold a public hearing at the Long Lake Town Hall, Long Lake, New York, on Wednesday, the 24th day of April, 2019 at 7:30 P.M. or as soon after previously scheduled hearings on other topics allow and that an opportunity to be heard in regard thereto will then and there be given to those favoring passage of such proposed local law and also to those opposed thereto. At such time and place all persons interested in the subject matter thereof will be heard concerning the same.
