- Buy a Long Lake sticker and put on your car * shoppers choice
- Visit the CV Whitney Long Lake Public Library.
- Use the wifi at the Beach Gazebo
- Climb Mt. Sabattis and check out the view
- Have breakfast at the Diner – No Visit to Long Lake is complete without this
Go to Bog River Falls* Located north of Long Lake (google directions)
- Pretend you're riding on the snowmobile trails and make loud noises while you do it
- Check out Wide River Antiques – reopening 2020 in new location! 1222 Main Street!
- Take in a Concert at St. Williams on Long Point in Raquette Lake on Thursday nights - all summer – BOAT REQUIRED! This is the only way to get to this venue. No shuttle boats available in 2020
- Get a bottle of Rachel's Raquette Lake Elixir and mix up a yummy Bloody Mary
- Boat cruise to Turtle Beach Where's that? The northernmost beach on Long Lake, NY

- Take in the sunset from the Long View Lodge and enjoy outdoor dining
- Take a walk on the Nature Trail – located behind the Boat Wash Station and see the new interpretive signage installed in 2020
- While you're at it, stop at the Long Lake Town Beach and take in the view and read up on Thomas Cole featured by a brand new NYS Historical Marker Sign

- Check out the tree growing up through Hoss's
- Buy a loaf of bread at Northern Borne (they have the best bread aisle view anywhere!)
- Check out the Raquette Lake 3 – Hike Death Brook Falls, Cathedral Pines & Ferd's Bog in Raquette Lake (Family friendly, we promise!)
- Read the cooler at Raquette Lake Supply
- Order Baked Goods at Raquette Lake Supply and please, thank Holly!

- Order Take Out from an area restaurant and eat dinner in a boat
- Visit the Blast Furnace in Newcomb access via the Upper Works Road just outside of Newcomb. Tahawas – super cool expedition for the family, it's a unique outdoor museum experience and it's FREE! ** Fill up with GAS before you go!
- Purchase party supplies at Ali Babas Liquors
- Visit both Burke's and Birds Marina in Raquette Lake
- Visit Wayne at the Raquette Lake Transfer station and ask him how the trails are
- Stop by the Raquette Lake Fire House to see the original Fire Truck from 1948
- Find the Fire Department Building - the new one and Find the Old One at the LL Town Hall
- Visit the Wild Center in Tupper Lake, NY

- Order a smoothie or any food item from Janet at the Lakeside Knoshery
- Overnight camp at a lean-to. Catlin Bay, Kelly's Point are good choices.
- Find the Historic Buttercup behind the Town Offices. Read the story

- Find the phone booth in town and call your cell phone
- Drive all the way to the very end of North Point Road and turnaround. Be mindful of private property. Make a short pit stop at the Canoe Carry and hike down to Forked Lake from North Point Road. Do not cross private property. Please!
- Have a Friday Lobster Roll at the ADK Trading Post

- Check out Forked Lake Campground and rent a canoe and paddle the waters
- Drive down Kickerville Road and turn around at the Historic Stone Gatehouse.
- Gas your boat up at the Long Lake Marina and ask Rachel about her favorite bird.
- Walk out to the Spillway Dam across from the Long Lake Town Beach
