DETERMINATIONS AND ANY LATER PROCEEDINGS AND HEARINGS, AND COPIES OF ALL ENVIRONMENTAL DOCUMENTS WILL BE MADE AVAILABLE TO YOU.

The Committee met on a regular basis to review existing plans, identify community issues and opportunities, engage residents, create concept drawings, and develop strategies to revitalize the Town. The plan contains a series of recommendations that touch on all aspects of the community, including but not limited to; recreation, housing, economic development, infrastructure, transportation, environmental protection, etc. The Comprehensive Plan is intended to be adopted by the Town Board and to serve as the official policy document of the Town.

The proposed action includes all local, regional, and state approvals necessary to authorize the proposed improvements and authorize construction of the structures and accessory development activities thereon. The proposed action may also require various permits and approvals from the involved agencies listed herein.
