

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**  
TOWN OF LONG LAKE  
County of Hamilton - State of New York

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that a proposed Resolution is scheduled to be considered at the Town Board's Wednesday January 27, 2021 Meeting. The Resolution is entitled: "Amendment to the October 25, 2006 Resolution to Change Annual Income Levels for the Senior Citizens Exemptions Granting those persons(s) Sixty-five years of Age or Older A Real Property Tax Sliding Scale Exemption According to Their Annual Income."

After public hearing on the matter, under provisions of Real Property Tax Law Section 467 (RPTL 467), the Town Board is authorized to grant the tax exemptions provided in the Resolution.

The Resolution would authorize and direct the Town Assessor to add 15%, 10% and 5% per cent exemptions to the sliding income scale that now only ranges between 50% to 20% on a sliding scale. The Resolution would authorize at each school district (Long Lake Central and Raquette Lake Union Free) discretion to utilize the three additional exemption levels.

The change is being considered because the underlying state statute has not been amended since 2006 to consider cost of living adjustments after 2009.

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that a public hearing upon the Resolution will be held on Wednesday, January 27, 2021 at 7:00 pm, at the Long Lake Town Hall, 1204 Main Street, Long Lake, NY and that an opportunity to be heard in regard thereto will then and there be given to those favoring and those opposed to passage of such proposed Resolution. At such time and place all persons interested in the subject matter thereof will be heard. Written comments received ahead of the Hearing shall also be considered. Please address them to the Town Supervisor, P.O. Box 307, Long Lake, NY 12847.

The hearing and the Town Board Meeting will be conducted in strict compliance with requirements for social distancing and masking on account of the COVID-19 pandemic.
