

**NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF RESOLUTION SUBJECT
TO PERMISSIVE REFERENDUM**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at a regular meeting held on the 30th day of December 2020, the TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF LONG LAKE duly adopted a resolution, entitled "Authorizing Conveyance of Property To David And Victoria Snide Subject To Permissive Referendum," an abstract of which follows and which resolution is subject to a permissive referendum as provided in Article 7 of the New York Town Law and shall become effective in 30 days unless there be filed with the Town Clerk a petition with sufficient signatures in conformance with New York Town Law Article 7.

Pursuant to Section 64.2 of New York Town Law, the resolution authorized the Town Supervisor to execute a deed and other transfer documents to David And Victoria Snide for real property currently owned by the Town. The transaction is to transfer of the Town's entire fee interest in approximately **0.16 acres** which is a spur of land off South Hill Road, a town road.

There is no assessed value the property and it has been deemed surplus and unneeded by the Town for any Town operations and would be better utilized in private ownership. No objection or interest in the property from any other adjoining owner has been received. The agreed upon purchase price is \$1.00.
