

AN EMERGENCY ORDER

Local Emergency Order for the Raquette Lake Water District located in the Town of Long Lake, Hamilton County, New York.

I, Clay J. Arsenault, the Chief Executive of the Town of Long Lake, in accordance with a declaration of a State of Emergency issued on AUGUST 19, 2022, and pursuant to Section 24 of the New York State Executive Law do hereby order


1. That all users of the Raquette Lake Water District must conserve water to the maximum extent possible to minimize water usage.
2. That the Town of Long Lake, as Owners of the Raquette Lake WD, shall perform all such activities to redevelop the wells including contracting with a hydrogeologist and well driller to evaluate, oversee and perform redevelopment of the wells.
3. That the Town of Long Lake, as Owners of the Raquette Lake WD, shall work with Hamilton County Emergency Services to obtain approval for continued use of the emergency tanker truck and work with the Hamilton County Emergency Services and the State Office of Emergency Services to obtain a portable cartridge filtration water treatment plant to treat nearby surface water to use as a water source during the time when the wells will be offline for redevelopment.

This order shall be in effect immediately and shall remain in effect until removed by order of the Chief Executive. This order may also be renewed in (30) thirty-day increments.


Failure to obey this order is a criminal offense, punishable by law under New York State Executive Lake, Article IIB.


