

# NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

## TOWN OF LONG LAKE County of Hamilton State of New York

Proposed Local Law - Introductory Number 2 -of 2024- A Local Law to Override the Tax Levy Limit Established in New York General Municipal Law §3-c.

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that a Local Law entitled: “Override of the Tax Levy Limit Established in General Municipal Law 3-c for the Town of Long Lake, Hamilton County for Fiscal Year 2025” has been introduced before the Town Board of the Town of Long Lake, Hamilton County and State of New York pursuant to Subdivision 5 of General Municipal Law §3-c, which expressly authorizes the Town Board to override the tax levy limit by the adoption of a Local Law approved by vote of sixty percent (60%) of the Town Board. This action will allow the Town Board to adopt a budget for town purposes for fiscal year 2025 that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the “tax levy limit” as defined by General Municipal Law §3-c.

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that a public hearing upon said will be held on Wednesday, October 30<sup>th</sup>, 2024, at 7:00 pm, the Town Hall, 1204 Main Street, within the Town of Long Lake, New York and that an opportunity to be heard in regard thereto will then and there be given to those favoring and to those opposed to passage of such proposed local law. At such time and place all persons interested in the subject matter thereof will be heard concerning the same. The deadline for timely consideration of comments is noon October 30<sup>th</sup>, 2024.
